Judging Process

The judges are seeking organisations that can demonstrate a sustainable approach to their activities. This could include:

- Leaving a positive legacy to our environment.
- Markedly reducing the impact of their activities on the environment.
- Creating a long-term sustainable environment.
- Programmes which have put the environment at the heart of the organisation.
- Using good environmental practices to improve business.
- Making best use of financial resources to deliver maximum sustainable impact.
- In the case of schools, demonstrate that the environment is a core value that staff and pupils embrace.

The judges will be judging the three categories separately before awarding the Jersey Electricity Environmental Award to the overall winner.

If you are entering either a large or small organisation, you should be able to:

- Demonstrate a local commitment to conservation and sustainability in your policies and practices.
- Good neighbour credentials (noise, light pollution, transport policies etc).
- Use of recycled materials.
- Offer supporting documentation.
- Show evidence of a deliberate policy of environmental improvement.
- If you have reduced energy consumption, please detail how you have achieved this through developing new work practices.

If you are entering as a school, you should be able to demonstrate:

- Evidence that the environment is a core value that all staff and pupils embrace.
- Evidence that environmental issues are part of the school time and extra time curriculum
- Evidence of communication and engagement.
- Evidence of benefit to the school and the community at large.

In all categories extra points will be awarded to any applicant that includes testimonials from those that have delivered the environmental action and those who have benefited from it.

Criteria

Large Organisations

Either a large employer or local division of a national/international business.

Small Organisations

Defined as employing fewer than 15 staff.

Schools

Open to all Jersey schools demonstrating that the environment is a core value that staff and pupils embrace.
